One 1L, One 2L, and One 3L from each of the following law schools will be awarded with Scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 each:

1. South Texas College of Law Houston
2. Thurgood Marshall School of Law
3. University of Houston Law Center

The scholarships will be awarded on a weighted scale on the basis of academic merit, leadership, and work experience, community service, and financial need.

To be considered, by 11:59 PM on March 28, 2023, applicants must send *one email* and include in *one pdf attachment* the following:

1. MABAH 2023 Scholarship Application Document;
2. Your current resume/curriculum vitae;
[shall include your academics (GPA), awards, employment, any MABAH and other Hispanic organizations/community service and extra-curricular data]
3. A 2-page written personal statement;
[must be double-spaced, with pages numbered, answering the following prompt: tell us “Why you deserve the MABAH scholarship.” We are reviewing for content and structure, i.e., what you write and how well you write it. Include your strengths as a law student, how your law degree will assist in meeting your goals and community service in the Hispanic community, including MABAH if applicable. The hardship aspect (see rubric), or what you’ve had to overcome in pursuing your education, should be included in your personal statement. This is not the topic of your personal statement, but should be one part of your personal statement, if applicable to your situation.]

Each area listed above will be scored according to the attached rubric. Please do not fill in the rubric. This a blind application review and no person reviewing your application will see your name, or other demographics that could create a bias in the review process.
