The Mexican American Bar Association of Houston will host the annual gala on October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at The Royal Sonesta Hotel and is happy to announce the scholarship application is now open! MABAH will be awarding a total of six (6) scholarships to deserving 2L and/or 3L law students already enrolled in a law school in Houston. Students from each of the following law schools will be awarded with Scholarships in the amounts of \$1,500 to \$3,000:

- South Texas College of Law Houston
- Thurgood Marshall School of Law
- University of Houston Law Center

The scholarships will be awarded on a weighted scale on the basis of academic merit, leadership, and work experience, community service, hardship, and financial need.

To be considered, by 11:59 PM on Monday, October 13, 2025, applicants must send *one email* and include in *one pdf attachment* the following:

- 1. 2025 MABAH Gala Scholarship Application Form;
- 2. Transcript (unofficial or official);
- 3. Your resume (shall include your academics (GPA), awards, employment, MABAH and other Hispanic organizations/community service and extra-curriculars);
- 4. A copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR). The SAR may be obtained from your FAFSA. (If you are unable to provide this and to establish financial need, please provide a list of your household expenses and list any scholarships you have received in the past year.);
- 5. Submit a 700-word essay or less, double-spaced, justified, with pages numbered, answering the following prompt:

**Personal Statement:** How do you define justice, and how will you pursue justice for marginalized communities as a practicing attorney? What inspired you to pursue a career in law or how do you see yourself making a future impact in the Hispanic legal community? How have you been involved with MABAH and/or how do you intend to incorporate MABAH's mission in your life as a law student and future attorney? What financial hardships have you experienced during your journey to and in law school and how have you overcome them?

The **financial hardship** aspect (see rubric on next page), or what you've overcome in pursuing your education, shall be included in your personal statement. We are reviewing for style, content, and structure.

**Scholarship Requirement:** The scholarship recipient will be presented at MABAH's Gala on October 24, 2025 at The Royal Sonesta Hotel and attendance is mandatory if you have been awarded a scholarship. In addition, the recipient must attend a MABAH general meeting in the future to introduce yourself and present to MABAH members and friends on how the scholarship has made a difference to your legal career.

**Equal Opportunity Policy**: MABAH provides equal treatment to all persons without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, disability, veteran status, or sexual orientation, except where such distinction is required by law.

Initial Review: This is a blind application review and no person reviewing your application will see your name, or other demographics that could create a bias in the review process. Your information is confidential and will not be shared with persons outside of the Scholarship Committee and Gala Committee. Therefore, it is imperative the application be sent only to <a href="mailto:mabahouston@gmail.com">mabahouston@gmail.com</a>. To maintain confidentiality, please remove your name from <a href="mailto:all">all</a> of your documents, including your resume. <a href="mailto:Your name should only be on the">Your name should only be on the</a> <a href="mailto:MABAH Application">MABAH Application</a>.

**Secondary Review:** Once the initial blind application review process has been completed, it is possible that the MABAH Scholarship and Gala Committee will reach out to you and other potential candidates for additional screening and interviewing.

Award recipients will be notified by the Committee on October 17th, 2025.
